Jounce Therapeutics, Inc. is a clinical-stage immunotherapy company dedicated to transforming the treatment of cancer by developing therapies that enable the immune system to attack tumors and provide long-lasting benefits to patients through a biomarker-driven approach. Jounce currently has multiple development-stage programs ongoing while simultaneously advancing additional early-stage assets from its robust discovery engine based on its Translational Science Platform. Jounce's lead product candidate, vopratelimab, is a monoclonal antibody that binds to and activates ICOS, and is currently being studied in the EMERGE Phase 2 trial. Vopratelimab will also be evaluated in the Phase 2 SELECT trial in combination with Jounce's internal investigational PD-1 inhibitor, JTX-4014, in biomarker selected patients using TIS^{vopra}. Jounce's next clinical candidate, JTX-8064, is a LILRB2 (ILT4) receptor antagonist shown to reprogram immune-suppressive tumor associated macrophages to an anti-tumor state. Additionally, Jounce has agreed to exclusively license worldwide rights to JTX-1811, a monoclonal antibody targeting CCR8 and designed to selectively deplete T regulatory cells in the tumor microenvironment, to Gilead Sciences.
